Macleod Village Green

Although one of the smaller play areas for Banyule City council, Macleod Village green is one of the most notable after its latest upgrade. Yellowstone Landscaping began the project fully aware of the high community expectations and eyes watch everything happening on site. The final product created by Yellowstone Landscaping in conjunction with Banyule City Council exceeded expectations. For decades, the train and classic play elements installed at Macleod Village green have entertained generations of children.

This latest upgrade brought the classic play space in to the 21st century with an interactive memo unit. The first of its kind in Victoria, the memo unit provides a variety of different games and interactive elements all with the use of 8 LED lit posts. This unit has become the most used unit in the world which is tracked by its European manufacturer. While the upgraded shelter and BBQ/Picnic setting have provided a place for family to congregate and enjoy some time together.

Although the project timeline occurred through harsh Covid-19 lockdown measures, working closely with Council, Yellowstone Landscaping managed to not just complete the project in the expected timeframe but donate the removed play space. In assistance of Rotary Club of Victoria, Yellowstone Landscaping administration and construction teams worked on Rotary Club's behalf while they were unable to assist. All this hard work meant that the older original play items are now rebuilt in Timor, located in Southeast Asia, for children to also enjoy.
