Yellowstone Landscaping collaborate with the Rotary Overseas Recycled Playground Program (RORP) through Rotary Club of Nunawading. Through this partnership, we focus on repurposing and recycling existing playground equipment instead of allowing it to end up in landfills. These playgrounds go to communities where safe playgrounds are not readily available, thereby enriching the lives of children and families in need. It's a wonderful example of sustainable practices and community outreach coming together to make a lasting impact. The current project we have been a part of (March 2024) is a 40ft container that was packed with 12 playgrounds from around Melbourne suburbs and has been sent over to Papua New Guinea awaiting to be installed for the local communities.
